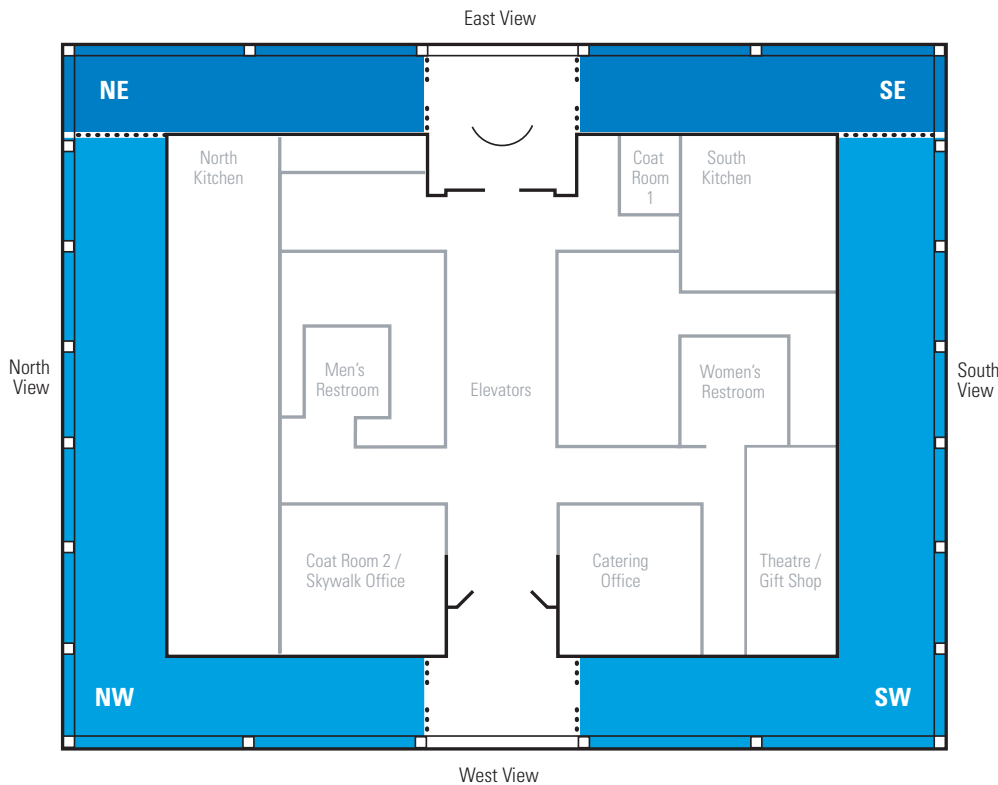


FLOOR PLANS: Skywalk 50th floor

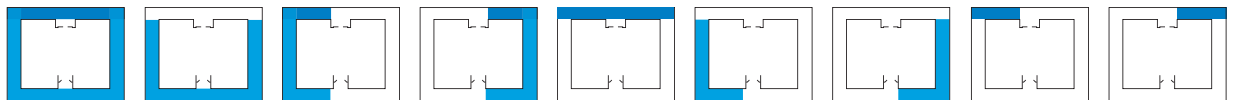


GREAT VIEWS OF THE CITY

The entire Skywalk has a 360 degree view of the city of Boston. Receptions for 500 to 800 guests fit comfortably in this space. Among the sites to see from the 50th floor are downtown Boston and the Financial District, Trinity Church, Logan Airport, Boston Harbor and the Islands, Back Bay, the Charles River, Cambridge, the South End, the JFK Library, Fenway Park, the Christian Science Museum, the Museum of Fine Arts and Symphony Hall.

Air walls – which are sliding solid doors shown at left as dotted lines – have been installed in the Skywalk to create smaller event spaces for events with 100-400 guests.

IEWS

The Northwest Wing is an "L"-shaped space with a fantastic view overlooking the northwest areas of Boston including the Charles River, Cambridge, Fenway Park, Back Bay neighborhood, the Christian Science Museum, the Museum of Fine Arts and Symphony Hall.

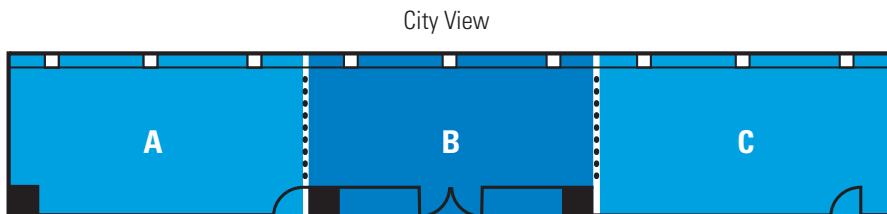
The Southwest Wing is also an "L"-shaped space overlooking the southwest areas of Boston including Fenway Park, Boston Harbor and the Islands, JFK Library, South End neighborhoods, the Christian Science Museum, the Museum of Fine Arts and Symphony Hall.

The Northeast Wing is a rectangular space with views of the north and east sides of the city including downtown Boston, Boston Common, the Financial District, Trinity Church, Boston Harbor and the Islands, Back Bay, the Charles River and Cambridge.

The Southeast Wing is a rectangular space primarily overlooking downtown Boston, Boston Common, the Financial District, Trinity Church, Boston Harbor and the Islands, the South End, the JFK Library and more.

FLOOR PLANS: Top of the Hub Fenway Rooms – 52nd floor



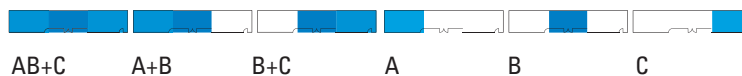
NEWLY RENOVATED PRIVATE DINING WITH CITY VIEWS AT TOP OF THE HUB

The Fenway Rooms A, B and C each seat an average of 20 guests. Air walls – which are sliding solid doors shown at left as dotted lines – may be opened between the Fenway Rooms to create larger event spaces.

The Fenway Room overlooks the southwest areas of Boston including Fenway Park, Boston Harbor and the Islands, JFK Library, South End neighborhoods, the Christian Science Museum, the Museum of Fine Arts and Symphony Hall.
